- Directive 2013/53/EU on recreational craft and personal watercraft



Issues to be addressed

- Build pleasure boats with clean propulsion, circular and fitted with latest ICT (information and communication technologies)
- Recycle of boats arriving at the end of their use
- Diverging national safety equipment rules for yachts
- Common curriculum for skippers (burden to mobility)
- Promotion of smart marinas
