

Yves Hénocque - Biography



After studying and a doctorate in Marine Ecology (1977), Yves Hénocque started his career in aquaculture and marine repopulation in connection with fishing. Returned to IFREMER in 1987, he extended his experience to the coastal environment then to the governance and integrated coastal zones management. He worked in the framework of many Mediterranean projects with the Mediterranean Action Plan and Regional Activity Centers such as Plan Bleu and the Priority Action Programme, and extended its experience in the management of integrated management projects in the Indian Ocean (Indian Ocean Commission) and Asia-Pacific, including Japan, Thailand, and the island states and territories of the South Pacific. Senior advisor for maritime policies and governance at IFREMER, he chairs the Sea and Coastal Committee of Fondation de France and is a member of the Plan Bleu's Bureau.
