Towards a shared vision on a sustainable Mediterranean in 2050, and transition issues

An innovative and participatory project (2018-2021)

MED 2050 is a **participatory foresight exercise** and a tool for North-South dialogue, aiming at confronting several possible visions of the future of the Mediterranean by 2050 (with an intermediate horizon at 2030) and co-constructing transition paths towards a more sustainable development.

What goals?

To **recreate links and feed debate** between countries of the **3 Mediterranean shores** on the region's future, via a **FORESIGHT NETWORK** and a **PARTICIPATORY approach**, allowing stakeholders (decision-makers, experts and members of civil society) to give their visions of the Mediterranean by 2030 and 2050 and to dialogue on this basis.

To replace the **sea and climate change** upstream of a **systemic thinking framework**.

To **co-develop solid, coherent and realistic TRANSITION PATHS** based on contrasting visions of actors, by working on the temporalities, bottlenecks, favorable factors, opportunities and risks to be overcome or valorized to reach desirable objectives.

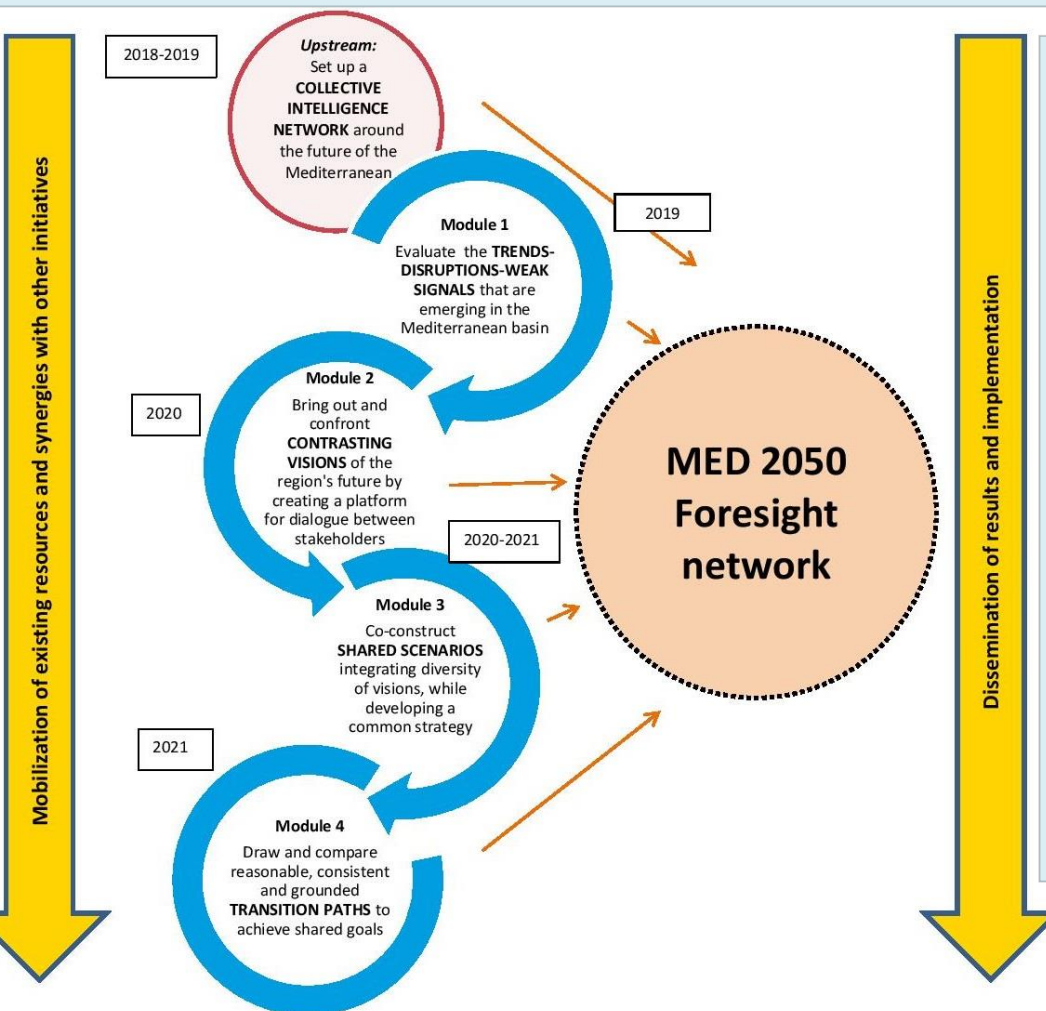
A modular organization

MED 2050 modules are successive and complementary, but each has its own utility.

MED 2050 Foresight Network is composed of experts, decision-makers and members of civil society from all Mediterranean countries.

This network will be active throughout MED 2050, and will communicate via a **WEB PLATFORM** on which members can **share documents, exchange information and share new initiatives** (local, regional) related to the future of the Mediterranean.

Mobilization of resources and dissemination of results will therefore be continuous throughout MED 2050, thanks to the innovative and collaborative foresight network.
