

ICZM Protocol for the Mediterranean


- ➤ ICZM Protocol signed (Madrid, 21 Jan 2008)
- To date: 15 signatories, 10 ratifications
- ➤ Entered into force 24th March 2011

Legal obligations: ICZM Protocol

Article 5 **Objectives of ICZM**

- Facilitate SD of coastal zones by ensuring that the environment and landscapes are taken into account in harmony with economic, social and cultural development;
- Preserve coastal zones for the benefit of current and future generations;
- Ensure the <u>sustainable use of natural resources</u>, particularly with regard to <u>water</u> use;
- Ensure <u>preservation of the integrity</u> of coastal ecosystems, landscapes and geomorphology;
- Prevent and/or reduce the effects of natural hazards and in particular of climate change, which can be induced by natural or human activities;
- Achieve <u>coherence between public and private initiatives</u> and between all decisions by the public authorities, at the national, regional and local levels, which affect the use of the coastal zone.



Legal obligations: ICZM Protocol

Article 9 Economic activities

- Accord specific attention to economic activities that require immediate proximity to the sea;
- Ensure that the various <u>economic activities minimize the use of natural resources</u> and take into account the <u>needs of future generations</u>;
- Ensure respect for integrated <u>water resources</u> management and environmentally sound <u>waste management</u>;
- Ensure that the coastal and maritime <u>economy is adapted</u> to the fragile nature of coastal zones and that resources of the sea are protected from <u>pollution</u>;
- Define <u>indicators of the development of economic activities</u> to ensure sustainable use of coastal zones and <u>reduce pressures</u> that exceed their <u>carrying</u> <u>capacity</u>;
- Promote <u>codes of good practice</u> among public authorities, economic actors and NGOs.

Article 9 Economic activities cont.
