CONCEPT

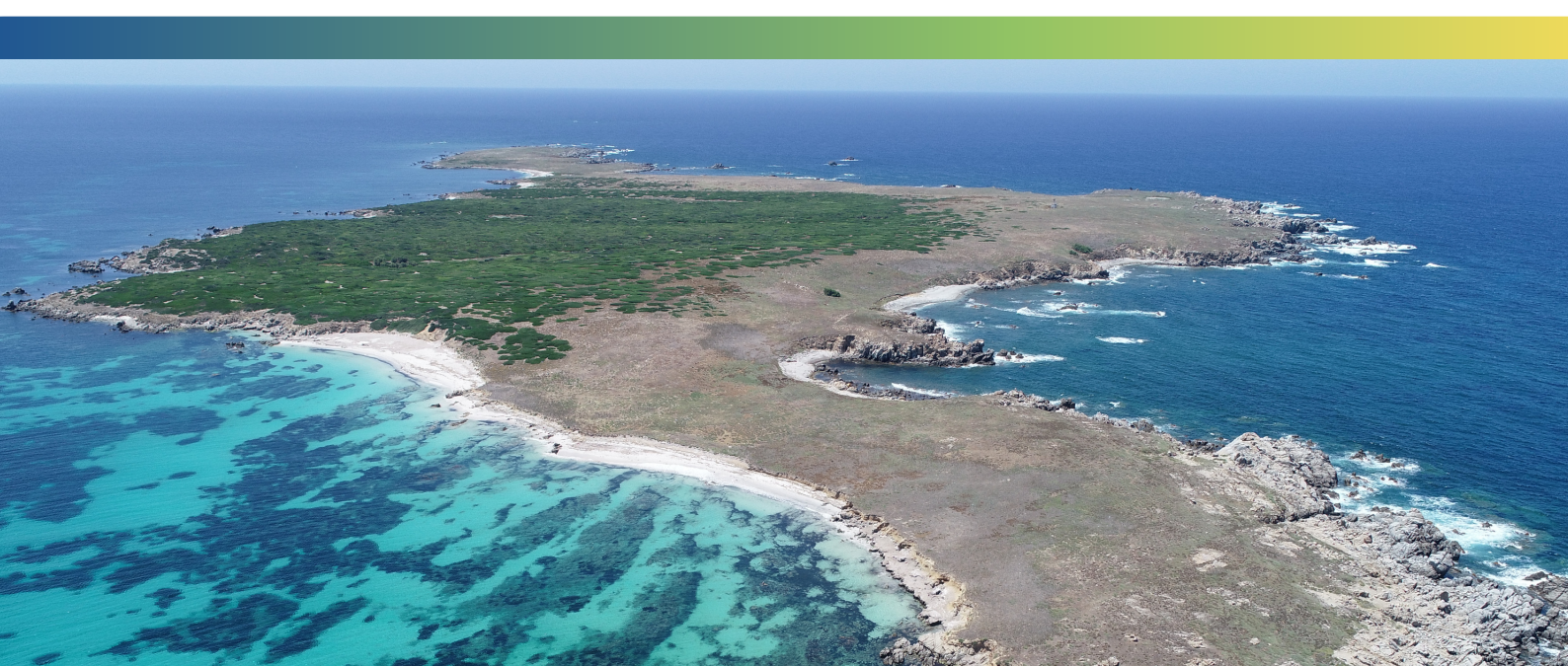
The workshop, organized by MEDSEA Foundation and MEDWET with the support of the Mediterranean Biodiversity Protection Community (MBPC), aims to present the Tune Up Project showing the methodology used and the importance of its implementation for the achievement of conservation and sustainable management results for Mediterranean MPAs.

The workshop will provide a moment for exchanging knowledge with the other projects of the MBPC Community and finding synergies to take in consideration a more coherent and integrated strategy for biodiversity preservation at the regional level.
