- 1st CAP event on Blue energy (Nov. 2020): 2-day event including a matchmaking session in the framework of the 1st BLUE DEAL Business Forum
- Informational meetings (Feb. 2021): Organized by CPMR to better understand the position of MED regions regarding the development of blue energy in their territories

Focus on the report "Towards a sustainable development of Marine renewable energies in the Mediterranean"


- A detailed description of BE technology developments : State of play, technology use description, energy capacity at EU level, the energy potential in the Med
- Best available tools and practices for Blue Energy :
- How to reconcile BE with biodiversity protection and other uses of the sea: Ensuring ecosystem protection and smoothing conflicts, Monitoring environmental impacts, how to combine BE production and other maritime activities
- Enabling conditions for Blue energy development: Policy framework, Barriers, Recommendations







- An opportunity for economic growth in the region to enhance the security of its energy supply and boost competitiveness through technological innovation
- An enormous but untapped potential, especially in Southern Mediterranean countries
- **Currently NO commercial development** of BE in the Mediterranean, despite their high potential impacts on socioeconomic characteristics
- The readiness level is low for most of the Mediterranean countries
- The two most advanced MRE, adapted and developed in the Mediterranean area are wind energy and wave energy
- Several large-scale pilot projects are currently developed.



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Why a delayed implementation of MRE in the MED region ?

- Mediterranean specific natural conditions
- Developing and implementing marine energy technologies has NOT been so far a priority in the Med region
- MRE sectors in the Mediterranean countries are at an early stage of development
- Administrative barriers, Complex licensing and consenting procedures.
- Lack of adequate financial instruments
- Infrastructural barrier
- Regulatory barrier
- Issues of public acceptance (linked to conflicts)
